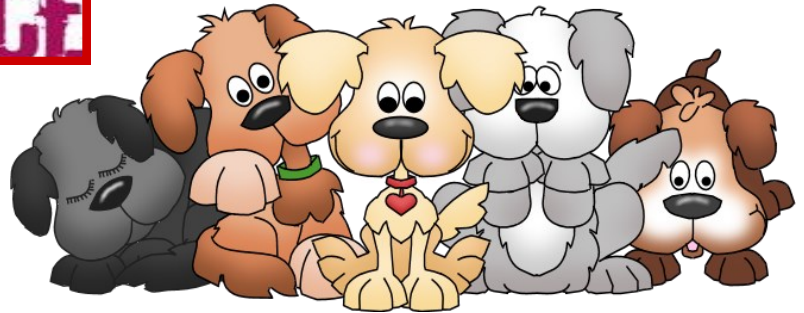




MISSION MATTERS: JUNE 2023

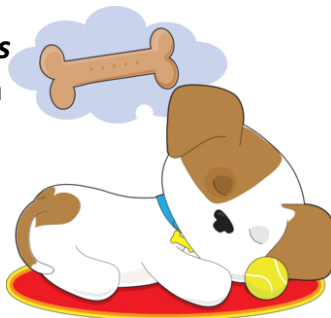
