Communities United for Health (C.U.P.S.)

It is about time for our **C.U.P.S.** (*Comunidades Unidas Pro Salud*) team to make another trip to the valley.

Island Presbyterian has been involved with the Communities United for Health mission program for many years and we usually make at least two trips to the valley to deliver school supplies, medical supplies and tech supplies. The mission team has purchased 45 back packs to fill with school supplies and we depend on our congregation to help with this endeavor.

There is a man named Rafael Salazar that is part of the cups ministry team in the valley and he meets us at a storage facility in Pharr, Texas to collect the supplies, then when there is a need, he delivers these items to schools and homes across the border.

So, if you have such things as walkers, walking canes, any medical items that you no longer use, we can certainly share these with the community. Also, iPads, computers, screens any electronics in working condition - we can use these.

And then school supplies: construction paper, multi colored spiral notebooks, pencils- #2 wooden, pens- blue and black ink, crayons, erasers, pencil sharpeners, rulers, glue sticks, scissors, etc.

There will be a big tub at the back of the sanctuary with a sign. Please help us fill our back packs with just what the children need for a perfect school term. Thank you for answering the call to do the Lord's work
