This year we have highlighted a single ministry each month in the newsletter. However, this month we have several endeavors and updates to report, so we are going off-script.

We are currently collecting school supplies for [Comunidades Unidas Pro Salud, \(C.U.P.S.\)](#) Island Presbyterian has supported this ministry for many years. **C.U.P.S.** serves the children of schools on both sides of our southern border. A collection bin for supplies is located in the back of the sanctuary where you will also find a list of needed items.

H.E.L.P. has arrived!!! [Our Health Equipment Loan Program](#) is finally open for business. We have canes, walkers, wheelchairs etc. available for short-term, no-cost rental to our church members and local community. Our dedicated **H.E.L.P. Line: 361-445-2999**. A team member will be available to answer the phone daily from 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Street Ministry needs sneakers, sunglasses, sunscreen, bug spray and visors. Items may be brought to the Mission Room on Tuesday or Thursday between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. (you may want to call the church first - 361-949-8770 - so we can unlock the door for you) or on Sunday. If you are traveling this summer, please remember that we always need travel-size toiletries.

Faith and Hope Foundation is in desperate need of foster families for dogs who are scheduled to be euthanized. The rescue will pay for vetting and supply food. We continue to collect puppy pads and **Purina Pro Plan** puppy and adult food for **Faith and Hope**. Leave donations in the Mission room and we will see that they are delivered.
